

Albert County Winter Carnival: Pure Winter Magic!

The Albert County Winter Carnival will be held Saturday, February 17, 2018 in the centre of Hillsborough. The community event offers free admission and activities, and free treats (including hot chocolate, maple taffy, and coffee). The carnival will feature free horsedrawn wagon rides by Broadleaf Guest Ranch and live entertainment. The event is a cornucopia of indoor and outdoor activities.

Festivities include skating, snowshoe and cross-country ski races, and the outdoor shinny hockey classic, along with ice golf putting, geocaching and demonstrations by the Fundy Blades Skating Club. The Kiwanis and Visitor Information Centres will provide warmup zones and washrooms.

Everyone is welcome to build a snowman and/or snow sculpture(s). A children's craft for all ages will be held at the Hillsborough Library. Colouring page contest entries from local elementary schools will be displayed at the Visitor Info Centre. Behind the centre, there will be family skating on the natural ice, a bonfire and marshmallow roasting.

An outdoor food truck near the Kiwanis will sell sandwiches, hamburgers, deep-fried mac & cheese, poutine, potato bomber egg rolls, a kid's special, and more. The Golden Oldies Snowmobile Club will display a vintage Snowmobile Show & Shine with dozens of antique sleds. Master craftsman Rob Milner of Eternity Chainsaw Carvings will demonstrate the art of carving throughout the day and evening. Raffle baskets will raise funds for the Fundy Blades Skating Club and Hillsborough Drop-In (tickets available Feb. 17 at the Kiwanis Club).

The unofficial carnival mascot, Albert the Snowman, "Big Al," was created by Doran and Ben Milton of Dawson Settlement. The 14-foot-tall creation is in Peace Park (Main St.). Visit the Albert County Winter Carnival Facebook page to see a complete schedule.

Getting your share of the money pie

You might think that because you receive social assistance or are a low-income earner there is no need to file your income tax return. However, depending on your personal situation, you may be eligible to receive credits and benefits by simply filing your annual income tax and benefit return. A single person with working income could receive up to \$1,043 for the federal Working Income Tax Benefit.

You could qualify for the GST/ HST Credit and New Brunswick
Harmonized Sales Tax Credit.
Adults and children with a disa-

bility could be eligible for a nonrefundable tax credit which reduces the amount of income tax they may have to pay.

• Parents can get up to \$6,400 annually for each child under the age of 6 and \$5,400 annually for each child aged 6-17 in the Canada Child Benefit and NB Child Tax Benefit.

• Parents with school-aged children could receive the School Supplement benefit of \$100 per child. • Your child could qualify for the Healthy Smiles, Clear Vision Plan (New Brunswick's dental and vision program for children of low-income families).

 Your child could qualify for the Canada Learning Bond, a federal program that offers up to \$2,000 for education after high school for children of low-income families.

• To find other benefits you may be eligible for, see www.canada benefits.gc.ca and NB Personal Income Tax.

* Under proposed legislation, this amount will increase starting in July 2018.

If you need help preparing your income tax and benefit return, the Community Volunteer Income Tax Program (CVITP) may be able to assist you. This free program is available to eligible taxpayers who have modest incomes and simple tax situations. For details, visit www.canada.ca/taxesvolunteer or call CRA at 1-800-959 -8281. Community Food Smart

During the winter months, produce can be quite expensive in the grocery stores. The Community Food Smart program by Foods of the Fundy Valley (FFV) is a way to get produce at wholesale prices. The produce bag costs \$15 and always contains 5 lb potatoes, 2 lb carrots, 2 lb onions, 5-6 apples, 3-4 oranges, and 2 lb bananas. There are usually 4-5 additional items.

Next order dates are February 21, March 21 and April 18 for pick-up on February 28, March 28 and April 25.

You can pre-purchase Community Food Smart bags and the produce will be delivered to the pick-up location of your choice. Bee Wise Beekeepers

Foods of the Fundy Valley has launched a beekeeping enthusiasts group. Bee Wise Beekeepers started in September 2017 and now has 19 members and dozens of followers on their Facebook page. Members include novice beekeepers, non-beekeepers, and commercial producers from the Fundy Valley and Greater Moncton area. Ages range from high school students through to retired enthusiasts. Meeting venues can vary, but all meetings to date have been held at the Riverview Sobeys community meeting room, the second Thursday of the month. Items of note so far are demonstrations on honey extraction, making mead, building a beehive, and rendering beeswax and products.

The group's mandate is to provide a forum for education, engagement and experience for those interested in learning about beekeeping through regular meetings, workshops, idea-sharing discussions and socializing. We wish to increase community awareness of the importance of bees to our food supply. Several exciting community projects will kick off in 2018.

Foods of the Fundy Valley recently received a monetary grant from Whole Kids Foundation which will be used by the Bee Wise Beekeeping group to create bee awareness. The group will purchase an observational hive that can be taken into schools to educate children on the importance of bees and show them the inner workings of the hive. The group will also purchase a fixed hive that will be placed in the Fundy Region where children can come visit to see the bees in action. The fixed hive will allow other interested groups to view the workings of a bee hive.
