It is that time of year again, the time when the big yellow buses are back on the road and the children are out on the sidewalks waiting to be picked up. During times when there are flashing yellow and red lights, drivers need to pay attention because this means that frequent stops are coming soon.

I thought this would be a good time to review some of the things that need to be remembered during the school year. In case you don't have children attending school or traveling on these buses and consequently are not aware of the driving rules, this can serve as a review for you. When the yellow lights are flashing on the school bus then the bus is about to stop within 150 feet. When the red lights are flashing and the stop arm is out, then the bus is stopped for students to either get on or off the bus. It is illegal to pass a school bus when either of these lights are flashing. You can face a large fine and lose several points off your driver's record. With recent funding announcements, school buses will be equipped with traffic cameras on them to show when other vehicles do not obey the relevant traffic laws. Remember to give yourself a little extra time on your morning and afternoon commutes and use patience when you see the big yellow buses. Help keep our children safe.

- is a person who embodies the selfless, humble spirit of Molly Kool?


- is a person who would not normally seek recognition for their contributions?

#### **3rd Celebration of "Love Your Covered Bridge Day"**

The 115 year old "Sawmill Creek Covered Bridge" received well deserved love and appreciation on Sunday, August 6, as community residents and visitors celebrated the 3rd "Love Your Covered Bridge Day" event, in recognition of the unique heritage of the covered bridges and the importance of their preservation.

It's not every day that you attend an event "inside" a covered bridge, seated within the massive wooden truss and beam structure, protected from the sun with the breeze keeping you cool and free from mosquitoes!

Following the Welcome by Dawne McLean, President, Albert County Historical Society; Greetings were offered by Gerry Gillcash, President, Association Heritage New Brunswick; Jim Coates, Fundy Albert Councillor; and Ray Boucher, President, Covered Bridge Conservation Association of NB. Gilles J. Hébert, Chair of National Historic Sites Committee of the Canadian Society of Civil Engineers, then shared an important announcement made in May 2023. The Covered Bridges of New Brunswick are now declared National Historic Civil Engineering Sites by the Canadian Society of Civil Engineers. Sawmill Creek Covered Bridge in Hopewell Hill has been chosen as the site where the bronze dedication plaque will be installed, which reads "LE PONT SAWMILL CREEK BRIDGE" Bridge Engineer, Andrew Wetmore and Bridge Builder, Albert E. Smye. Project plans are underway to install the dedication plaque!

Singers and musicians (playing guitar, banjo and harmonica) joined together as the "Covered Bridge Band": Betty Weston, Dawne McLean, Oliver Smith, Darrell Mcaulay, Jim and Sue McLaughlin, Jarod Fenwick and Eric Steeves. Two poems, "My Grandfather's Store" and "Grindstone Island", composed by Diane Reid Tingley remembering Albert County's past days were greatly appreciated. Grateful thanks to the Youth Group from Albert Mines Baptist Church for providing a refreshment table of pop, water and sweet treats, with the proceeds towards their "Meals for Seniors" community project.

Three 2024 Covered Bridge Calendars were presented as prizes. Congratulations to Alex Steeves, who won the raffle prize of a large framed photo of the Sawmill Creek Bridge, donated by Ray Boucher. There is a tremendous need for a new "Sawmill Creek Covered Bridge" road sign at the entrance driveway! Fundraising efforts for a new sign kicked off with the photo raffle draw at the bridge event, as well as receiving donations "in the jar"! The Albert County Historical Society appreciates the support from the community and community organizations in working together to install a new road sign! Good news of another fundraising opportunity! Purchase a "Sawmill Creek Covered Bridge" license plate for \$28.00 at the Albert County Museum, with \$6.00 from each license plate sold being donated towards the new sign.
